The Division of Clinical Laboratory Science Department of Allied Health Sciences, UNC School of Medicine, invites applications for two faculty positions. The Division of Clinical Laboratory Science offers a baccalaureate degree in Clinical Laboratory Science and a Master's Degree in Clinical Laboratory Science – Molecular Diagnostic Science track. Responsibilities include teaching on-line courses, on-campus courses, and coordination of clinical education courses. The faculty members will also be expected to participate in the service and research missions of the Division of CLS.

**Qualifications:**

A minimum of a Master's Degree (Ph.D preferred), clinical laboratory teaching experience, and evidence of scholarly excellence or potential are required. For one position, the candidate must have or be eligible for molecular biology certification (ASCP-BOC or ABMG). For the other position, the candidate must have or be eligible for generalist certification (ASCP-BOC). Clinical experience and expertise in molecular diagnostics, microbiology, or clinical chemistry are highly desirable.
