These disciplines will grow as follows in comparison to all occupations in the U.S.

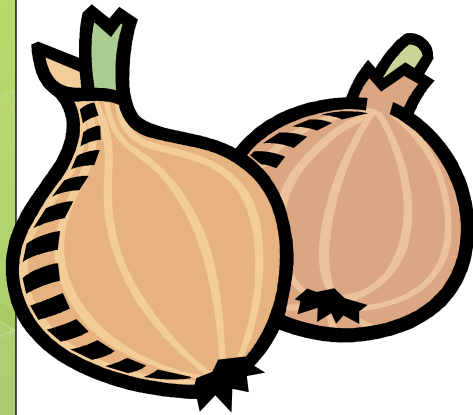
Occupation	Rate of growth expected by 2016
Audiologists	10% - As fast as the average
Clinical Lab Scientists	14% - faster than the average
Occupational Therapy	23% - much faster than the average
Physical Therapy	27% - much faster than the average
Radiologic Technologists	15% - faster than the average
Speech Language Pathologists	11% - about as fast as the average

Honor Code of UNC

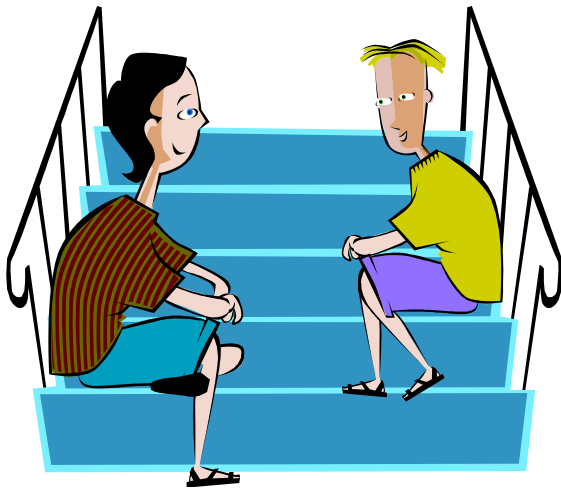

Judicial System



FERPA

(Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act)



- Regulates the release of student data by creating two categories of information: **directory information** and **non-directory information**.
- Protects the confidentiality of student academic records by allowing students to restrict the release of their directory info
- Allows the student to inspect his or her record and request amendment.

HIPAA

Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996

- Law passed by congress to:
 - Provide consumers with greater access to health care insurance
 - Protect the privacy of health care data
 - Promote more standardization and efficiency in the health care industry

Access Badges

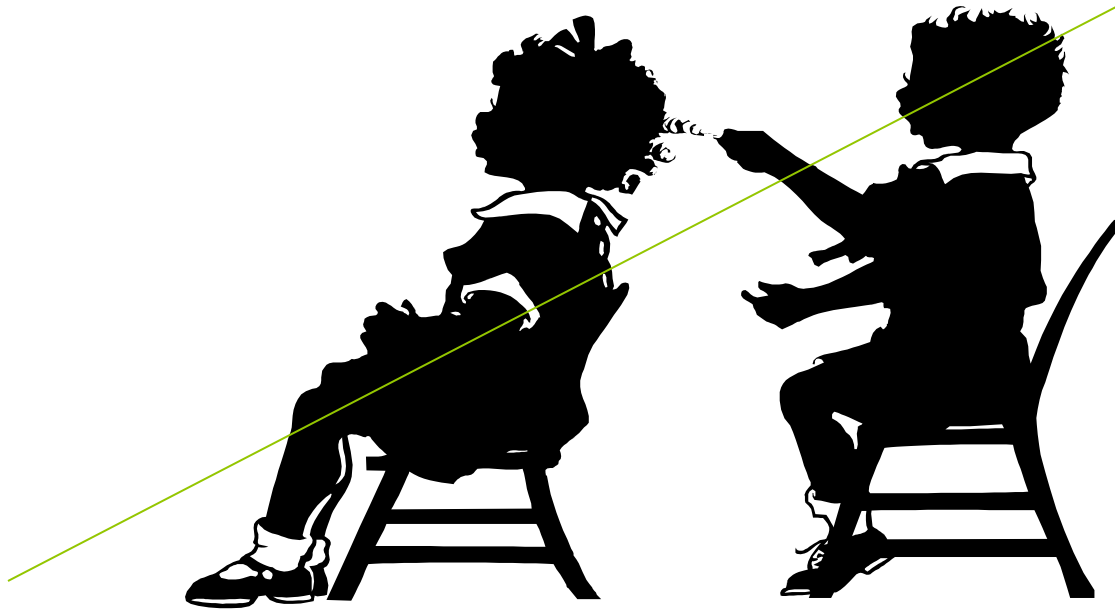
- The access badge is a picture identification badge which gives access to the building

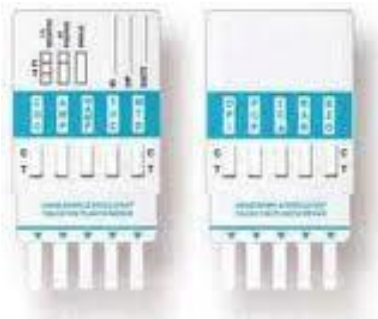
