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COURSE DESCRIPTION:

The UNC Advances in Urology will highlight several new developments in the field of urology. Topics to be covered include novel approaches to the evaluation of hematuria, practical approaches to the management of testicular cancer, innovations in prostate cancer biomarkers, advances in the treatment of urothelial cancer, and the latest guidelines for non-muscle invasive bladder cancer. A panel discussion will highlight the latest approaches for prostate imaging and biopsy. The attendee will realize the role of the urologist in the era of IVF, learn about efficacy and concerns of testosterone therapy, and review challenging cases of hypogonadism with an expert panel. Management strategies for refractory overactive bladder and incontinence associated with pelvic organ prolapse will be described. The optimal antibiotic use during kidney stone surgery and the recent evidence regarding UTT's in the neurogenic bladder will be examined. Lastly, complications in robotic urologic surgery and penile implant surgery will be discussed.
