Graduate Certificate in Nanomedicine

Nanomedicine is a rapidly growing area of science that involves the integration of nanotechnology and biomedical research. The purpose of this program is to provide training for students and postdocs in this emerging field. This program provides a UNC Graduate School Certificate that students (or postdocs) can earn in parallel with their primary Ph.D. program.

Requirements:

- 9 credit hours of coursework
- 6 hours additional to graduate program requirements

Including:

1. Nanomedicine course
2. Research rotation in cross-disciplinary lab
3. 2 courses complementary to area of expertise
