

Related Health Care Skills and Knowledge

This component of the course provides students an opportunity to develop related (non-clinical) health care skills and knowledge that will help them to be more effective physicians. The students will develop their own learning objectives for this component of the course with guidance from their UNC Ambulatory Care Selective Department Coordinator. We do not expect you to guide the students' work in this area; however, we do ask that you allow time (six full days) in students' schedules to permit this learning and that you serve as a resource whenever possible.

Scheduling
