Description:

Join us for the 18th annual Carolina Summer Institute. Our institute consists of online coursework to complete prior to attendance, workshop based learning on site, along with hands-on coaching instruction in the practice of Listening and Spoken Language therapy with Certified LSL instructors.

This year's Institute will provide instruction and training to audiologists, speech-language pathologists, and teachers of the deaf who wish to develop their skills in Auditory-Verbal Therapy, a listening and spoken language approach for children with hearing loss.

Topics to be covered include, but are not limited to:

- *Planning and Implementing the Auditory-Verbal Session*
- *The Development of an Auditory Feedback Loop: Strategies for Speech Babble and Critical Elements*
- *Beyond Input: Strategies for the Elicitation of Specific Vocabulary and Language Targets*
- *Conduction a tele-practice session using LSL techniques and strategies*

Training will occur through online reading & assignments, lectures, discussions, videotape analysis, self-study and hands-on practicum experiences with children who are enrolled in Listening and Spoken Language Therapy and their families.

Now in its eighteenth year, the *Carolina Summer Institute* has provided training in the principles and practice of Listening and Spoken Language Therapy to over two hundred professionals from around the world.

Food, Lodging, & Parking

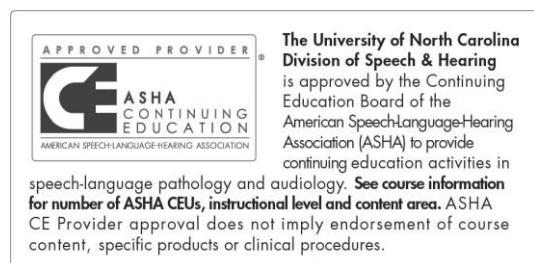

Approval from the A.G. Bell Academy for LSLs continuing education credits is being sought as well.

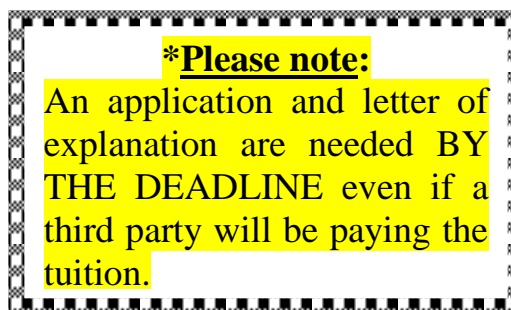
