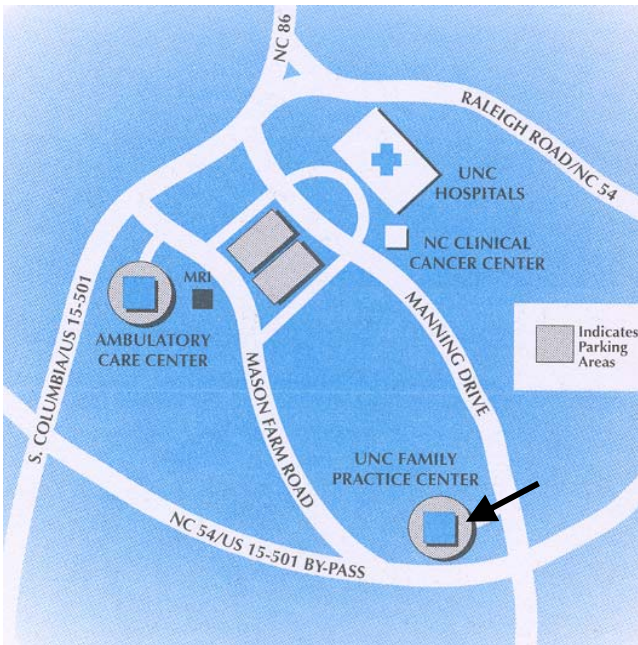


Directions

The Family Medicine Center is one of the more than 150 outpatient clinics provided by faculty of the UNC-Chapel Hill School of Medicine in association with UNC Hospitals. It is located four blocks from the new NC Women's Hospital and NC Children's Hospital at the corner of 15-501 Bypass and Manning Drive.

We offer free parking to patients while they are visiting the FMC. Chapel Hill transit also makes stops at the clinic on the CM, RU, and V routes. The S and U routes have stops within walking distance as well.

Our Philosophy for Pediatric Care

Having a child is one of the most important events in a family's life. At the UNC Family Medicine Center, we recognize this and strive to exceed your expectations through care that centers on listening to your family's needs and supporting you as a parent.

We also believe that continuous care throughout your child's life is important. We are organized into care teams so that you and your child can develop an ongoing relationship with a small group of providers.



What Pediatric Services are Offered?

The UNC Family Medicine Center provides a broad range of services to you and your family. This includes:

- Care by family physicians
- Advice nurse available 24 hours a day
- Lactation consultant on staff
- Nurse midwife/ nurse practitioner on staff
- Child Services Coordinator on staff
- Saturday morning clinic
- Same day appointments
- Group visits for preventive care ["Centering Parenting"]
- On site laboratory and x-ray
- Pregnancy, childbirth, and parenting information, including a lending library
- Free pediatrics information sessions [call 966-2109]

If You Need Specialized Care

As a clinic within the UNC Healthcare System, we have access to a full range of pediatric sub-specialists. If your child needs this type of care, we can help coordinate specialty services for you.

What Do I Do If My Child Is Sick?

When questions arise between your visits, you can call the Family Medicine Center at [919] 966-0210. If your child is sick, the receptionist will offer to schedule an appointment for your child that day. If you need immediate medical advice, you may ask to speak to our advice nurse who is available during office hours.

After Hours Care

Medical care and advice from a nurse or doctor is available 24 hours a day by calling [919] 966-0210. After business hours, these calls are handled by a UNC Healthlink nurse and the doctor on call. If you are experiencing a medical emergency, you should call 911.

How Do I Reach My Doctor?

To leave a non-urgent message for your doctor, you may send an email to your doctor by using our website at www.unchealthcare.org/fpc or you may call (919) 966-0210 and select option 3 on the automated call system. Every effort will be made for your provider or his or her staff to contact you within 24 to 48 hours after receiving your message.
