

How to prepare for your visit

- ❑ Bring your medicine calendar from your last clinic visit
- ❑ Bring your UNC medical record card
- ❑ Bring your insurance card
- ❑ Bring your medicines and let your provider know if you need refills
- ❑ Bring your glucose meter if you have one
- ❑ Make a list of questions you may have for your provider
 1. What is my main problem?
 2. What do I need to do?
 3. Why is it important for me to do this?
- ❑ Bring records from any recent doctor visits or hospital stays if you are seen somewhere other than UNC
- ❑ Take your medicines as you usually do the day of your visit
