

Article 7 Academic Assistance

7.01 Academic Assistance

- (1) The School of Medicine provides academic assistance to students who have remediable academic difficulties.
- (2) Academic assistance includes tutoring, academic skill development counseling, and monitoring progress.
- (3) All academic assistance is coordinated through the Office of Student Affairs.

7.02 Feed Forward

- (1) With student permission, student evaluation data may be fed forward through the Office of Student Affairs to subsequent course directors to facilitate targeted academic assistance.
- (2) Student evaluation data should be submitted as early as possible during a course, but no later than two weeks following the end of the course.
- (3) A student decision to refuse permission to pass on the Feed Forward data may be overridden if faculty, in consultation with the course director, the Dean's Office, or other senior faculty, determine that the student's deficit represents a significant risk of compromising patient care or disrupting the healthcare team.
