



The Lucius Blanchard Carolina Family Loyalty Fund Scholarship Program

The premier scholarship program of the UNC School of Medicine, the Lucius Blanchard Carolina Family Loyalty Fund Scholarships are awarded annually to four incoming medical students who demonstrate outstanding academic achievement, strong curiosity, leadership qualities, and commitment to service and, in some cases, financial need. These students enjoy the benefits of the Blanchard Scholarship throughout their four years of medical school.

The Blanchard Scholarship provides:

- A four-year renewable scholarship intended to equal, as near as possible, the cost of in-state tuition.
- A Carolina Family Loan will provide an interest-free loan of \$20,000 a year for four years. The student has up to 10 years after graduation from medical school to repay the loan.
- Carolina Family Enrichment funds designated annually to enhance the student's educational experience. Money from the fund can be used for research projects, travel or other expenses related to their education.

The Blanchard Carolina Family Loyalty Fund Scholarship and Loan Program was established in 2008 through the generosity of Dr. Lucius Blanchard, a member of the Class of 1968.
