Selection Criteria**

SELECTION CRITERIA:

1. Breadth of personal and academic experience, as evidenced by candidate’s CV and experience outlined in application.
2. Demonstrated service to the School of Medicine and/or greater communities
3. Demonstrated work or research experience which has furthered a particular field or the School of Medicine
4. Student adequately demonstrates how the award will assist them in reaching their goals

Breadth of personal and academic experience	Personal or academic experiences are mostly absent from the application or they are poorly displayed.			Application demonstrates a very unique set of personal and academic experiences that sets them apart from their peers.
Service	Little to no service to the School and/or greater community is demonstrated in the application.			Application demonstrates a variety of different service commitments to the School and greater community and the impact of those efforts is clearly displayed.
Work/Research Experience	Little to no work or research experience is demonstrated in this application.			Application demonstrates a variety of work/research experiences which are shown to have made substantial impact in a given field or to the School of Medicine.
Clarity of goals	Student is not able to articulate their short-term goals or any specifics about how the scholarship will help them succeed.			Student demonstrates clear goals for the coming year and articulates specifically how the scholarship will play a role in helping them succeed.
