RESEARCH STATEMENT

I have published over 30 peer-reviewed educational research journal articles. I have made original contributions to medical education research with a focus on the application of learning from instructions and assessment to education in healthcare professions. I have investigated a variety of topics on the use of technology-enhanced assessment and active learning techniques in medical education such as flipped classrooms and simulation-based assessment for learning. The significant contributions of my work in medical education research have been recognized by the multiple paper and national/international conference abstract awards I have been granted. In addition, my professional service as a judge of the work of others in medical education is highly recognized and acclaimed by the journal editors and the international educational research community.

Advances in medicine and medical education demand rigorous assessment and evaluation to assure that they are effective and will ultimately improve medical care. Distinguished medical practitioners who develop new

treatments or diagnostic procedures rarely have the knowledge and skills to conduct the appropriate assessment tools and rigorous evaluations needed so that the advances reach the field and improve medical practice. My contribution has been to work in tandem with innovative practitioners and educators who develop knowledge and invent practices and procedures that lead to improved practice and, in turn, improved health of our population.

I have been an active member of several DEI special interest groups, including the UNC SOM New Asian American Faculty Association Group, UNC Health Asian American Interest Group, and The Society of Directors of Research Medical Education (SDRME) Special Interest Group member on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion. I have presented and moderated several workshops at SDRME Annual Meetings and AERA annual convention on the topic of the DEIJ. Through my DEI related work, I made contributions to framing educational research as a lever for social justice, and help learners identify research methods that facilitate recognition and exploration of DEIJ perspectives in the research process. All these works are beneficial to raising awareness of evolving research and assessment methods that attend to aspects of DEIJ, linking that to DEIJ efforts across the professions, and sharing both good practices and challenges.

TEACHING STATEMENT

I am currently the co-director of the Anesthesiology Resident Academic Medicine Rotation of Department of Anesthesiology, UNC. While managing the administration of the rotation, I also teach several reoccurring special topic workshop sessions on quality improvement statistics, research design, and academic abstract writing. I view teaching as not merely an exercise in conveying facts, but also as an opportunity to provide tools. My primary goal as a teacher is to provide students with thinking and problem-solving skills that benefit their learning and development. To help my students obtain a scientific perspective on research, I assign tasks and inclass activities that resemble what the professionals do in real-life academic practices. I require my students to write abstracts and research proposal on topics they find interesting, present their ideas to their peers in poster sessions, provide and receive constructive critiques on the works by themselves and their peers, and provide multiple opportunities for revision on their work based on feedback from teacher, peers, and criteria-referenced self-assessment. The authentic tasks not only allow my students to experience real-life professional challenges and work practices, but also give them opportunities to apply the methodological knowledge they learn onto their own projects. The articulation of feedback and comments to the works by themselves and their peers also acts as a good process during which students have the opportunities to deepen their understanding of the knowledge and methodology under discussion as well as to take a scientific perspective on research process and findings. The use of authentic tasks and formative assessment collectively makes my students well-grounded in the scientific study approaches and able to carry the scientific perspective with them as they continue to learn more about medicine and patient care in the future.

It is my hope that the learning experiences in my class equip my students with some essential thinking skills and fundamental knowledge that are required for educated consumers in the era of knowledge explosion.
