The goal of this position is to convert these associations into actionable biological insights. We urgently need to characterize the molecular and cellular changes resulting from these associations using gene expression and functional studies in multiple cellular assays (e.g., neuronal cell lines, mouse models, and patient-derived iPSCs). This work is part of a novel high-throughput pipeline involving multiple international groups.

Qualifications: PhD in genetics required. The successful applicant must have demonstrated excellence in applying multiple technologies in the service of understanding the consequences of genetic variation.
