UNC Health Office of Research Support and Compliance (ORSC)

The UNC Health Care System (UNHCS) includes hospitals across the state that serve the people of North Carolina. Conducting research activities at locations outside of the UNC Chapel Hill Medical Center can broaden the impact and diversity of your study data. The UNHCS Office of Research Support and Compliance (ORSC) serves to enable research in the network entities.

The UNHCS ORSC ensures that research projects conducted at UNC Health network entities are compliant with both UNC Health policies as well as applicable regulations.

Frequently Asked Questions:

When would I need to work with the UNHCS ORSC?

If you are planning to conduct research at any of the UNC Health network entities, you must contact the UNHCS ORSC.

I'd like to conduct research at one of the network entities. What do I need to do?

Begin by filling out this [Collaboration Survey](#). One of the ORSC project managers will contact you to initiate the collaboration pre-review and clearance process for your project.

Can I begin working at the network entities once I have IRB approval?

No, you must have approval from both the UNC IRB and clearance from UNHCS ORSC prior to initiating any study activities at any of the UNHCS network entities.
