## Key Note Speaker

*Joan Y. Reede*

Appointed as the first Dean for Diversity and Community Partnership in January 2002, Joan Y. Reede is responsible for the development and management of a program that provides leadership, guidance, and support to promote the increased recruitment, retention, and advancement of underrepresented minority faculty at Harvard Medical School (HMS). In 1990 she founded the HMS Minority Faculty Development Program and in 2008 became the Director of the Harvard Catalyst Program. Dr. Reede graduated from Brown University and Mount Sinai School of Medicine. She completed her Pediatric residency at Johns Hopkins Hospital and fellowship in child psychiatry at Boston.
