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The Adult Disability Medical Healthcare (ADMH)

Individuals living with developmental disabilities experience significant health and healthcare disparities. ADMH was founded to address these disparities and provide a comprehensive interdisciplinary team approach to addressing healthcare and social service needs in this patient population.

ADMH

- Non-profit established in the setting of our primary care practice funded solely with grants and fundraising efforts.
- Founded in 2014 our clinic initially saw patients with Down syndrome and have now expanded to all disabilities – most common DS, autism, cerebral palsy.
- Patients are seen in the context of a PCMH we partner with a social worker, behavioral specialist and dietician to provide comprehensive care.
- Two-fold role we act as primary care providers for patients and for some as consultants.

ADMH

- Appointments are 2-2.5 hours and provide as many services on site as possible.
- Our niche is transition and transition planning. Individuals with disabilities have many transitions throughout life. We focus on pediatric to adult transitions.
- We carry forward medical plans to adult world but also engage with patients and families about emergency plans, long term planning and guardianship.
