

INVITATION TO JOIN **2022 UNC HEALER'S ART COURSE**

The Healer's Art course provides support for medical students in recognizing, valuing, and preserving the human dimension of health care. Students and faculty participate together in a discovery model. The process-based curriculum enables students to appreciate the personal and universal meaning of medicine, in their daily lives.

The 15-hour elective course for students consists of five evening sessions. Each three-hour session is divided into a large-group and small-group experience. Small groups are facilitated by physicians recruited from medical school faculty and the community. Each session builds upon the insights and content of the previous session. The five session topics are:

- Discovering and Nurturing Your Wholeness
- Sharing Grief and Honoring Loss (2 sessions)
- Beyond Analysis: Allowing Awe in Medicine
- The Care of the Soul: Service as a Way of Life

Over the course duration, group members remain constant, allowing growth of comfort and trust. Faculty facilitators include Drs. Amy Weil, Beth Rosenberg, Dana Iglesias, Jen Martini, Jessica Barnhill, Laura House, Sarah Dotters-Katz, Sarah Ruff, Sue Slatkoff, and Tracy Deselm.

We will offer a hybrid format again, with students choosing to attend in-person or virtual. Sessions will take place on Thursday evenings - January 13, 20, and 27 and February 10 and 17, 2022.
