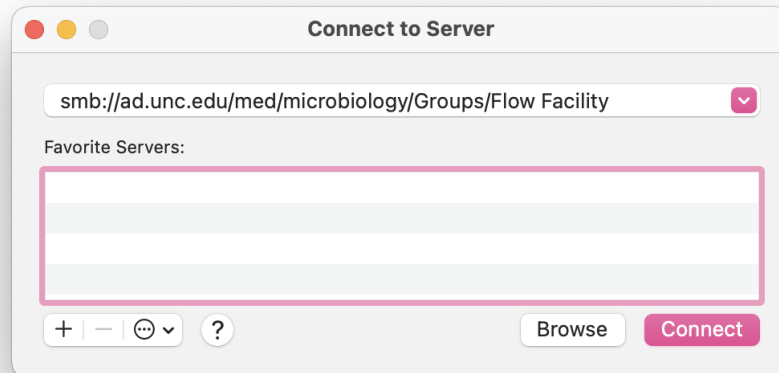


Accessing the Flow Cytometry Core Facility Network Folder (MacOS)

Mapping the shortcut

To create the shortcut to the Flow Core file server, go to your desktop. On the top menu click: *Go > Connect to Server*. Enter the following location and click "+": <smb://ad.unc.edu/med/microbiology/Groups/Flow> Facility



Clicking "+" adds this server as a Favorite. Click *Connect* to connect to the network location.

Troubleshooting

You may be prompted for a password. For the username, enter your ONYEN then your ONYEN password in the following format:

Username: AD\< > your ONYEN >

Password: <your current ONYEN password >

Note: if you are off the campus Wi-Fi, you will need to be connected via the VPN. Instructions are found on ITs website here:
