## Mapping the shortcut

To create the shortcut to the Flow Core file server, go to your desktop. On the top menu click: *Go > Connect to Server*. Enter the following location and click "+": smb://ad.unc.edu/med/microbiology/Groups/Flow Facility

Clicking "+" adds this server as a Favorite. Click Connect to connect to the network location.

## Troubleshooting

You may be prompted for a password. For the username, enter your ONYEN then your ONYEN password in the following format:

Username: AD\< your ONYEN>

Password: <your current ONYEN password>
