Secondary responsibilities include clinical teaching and service in the orthopedic residency and doctor of physical therapy degree programs.

Required Qualifications and Experience:

Applicants must have a doctor of physical therapy degree and be licensed or eligible for PT licensure in North Carolina. Completion of an orthopedic residency program OR minimum of 2 years clinical experience is required.

Preferred Experienced:

Current ABPTS certification or plans to complete in near future are preferred. Experience in teaching and knowledge/skill in manual therapy are preferred
