

TITLE OF POLICY

TEC 2.0 Monitoring Student Time in the Foundation Phase

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

Establishes the hourly limit of scheduled and required educational activities each week in the Foundation Phase. This policy applies to all courses within the Foundation Phase.

RESPONSIBLE PARTY AND REVIEW CYCLE

The Education Committee will review the policy on an as-needed basis according to the Foundation Phase Committee's evaluation and input.

POLICY

The Foundation Phase is composed of five required courses each semester: 3 Medical Science Courses, Patient Centered Care Course, and Social and Health Systems. Concurrent courses cannot exceed 25 *scheduled* hours per week and cannot exceed 30 *required* hours per week. Scheduled hours include CBL sessions, PALS, other small groups, patient presentations, labs, dissections, quizzes, and examinations. Required hours include scheduled hours as well as the following activities: simulations, prosections, required computer-based modules and assigned self-directed learning group work. Required activities do not include assigned readings, review of educational materials or exam preparation.

PROCEDURE(S):

The Foundation Phase records and monitors weekly hours during course and phase evaluations.
