UNC recognizes the diversity of career interests and goals of specialists seeking subspecialty training in REI. While the structure of the program is standardized, each trainee will have a focus or “track” that supports their career goals. Examples of tracks include:

- 1) Traditional academic
 - a. Focus on building a foundation for future independent investigation
 - b. Basic science, clinical, or translational investigation
 - c. Opportunity to seek a Master of Science in Clinical Research
- 2) Healthcare leadership
 - a. Build our future leaders in the delivery of reproductive healthcare
 - b. Training on quality improvement/quality assurance methods
 - c. Research will focus on innovative reproductive healthcare delivery
- 3) Reproductive surgery
 - a. Additional clinical training with MIGS surgeons
 - b. Research will focus on advancing the field of reproductive surgery
- 4) Medical education
 - a. Train to become an education leader
 - b. Research will focus on innovative methods/curriculum in reproductive medicine
