



Payment for your pregnancy-related care at UNC Health

Congratulations on your pregnancy! At UNC OBGYN, we are proud to partner with your primary OB provider for your prenatal care. Payment for prenatal care can be confusing. We ask that you speak with one of our Financial Navigators for information about medical bills during your pregnancy.

Your primary OB provider may bill your insurance a “global fee” for your pregnancy. This means that prenatal visits and the postpartum visit will be billed as part of a single charge with the delivery. There will not be a separate bill after each visit. The global fee is billed after the delivery of your baby and there is typically an “out of pocket” amount you will need to pay.

Your primary OB provider referred you to UNC OBGYN for additional services. You may have tests, ultrasounds, consults or visits with our specialists. These will be billed separately from any global billing associated with your routine prenatal visits with your primary OB provider. You can expect to receive other physician or hospital bills for these services.

At the time of your appointment(s) with UNC OBGYN, you will be required to pay the full amount of the estimated cost of the visit, ultrasound, test or procedure based on your insurance coverage benefits.

For patients with Medicaid and patients who are a part of the UNC Patient Financial Assistance Program, your copay will be collected at each visit.

You could get a separate bill for the following services:

- Consults or other specialist visits
- Ultrasounds
- Genetic counseling & genetic testing
- Visits not related to pregnancy
- Fetal non-stress tests
- Nutrition visits
- Blood tests
- Inpatient care >24 hours before delivery
