

COVID-19 Testing Guide for UNC Students and Postdoctoral Trainees

Do you have symptoms of COVID-19?

Do you work and/or attend class on campus?*

UNC-CH is able to manage the testing of symptomatic on-campus individuals for faculty and staff. Campus Health is able to manage symptomatic and asymptomatic (e.g. close contacts) students and postdoctoral trainees.

Have you been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or have symptoms of COVID-19?*

If you have been in a situation that may have been high risk, have no symptoms and are concerned about exposure to COVID-19, please contact a health care provider for further discussion.

If you are a student or postdoctoral trainee and use Campus Health as your primary care provider.

Step One: call [UNC Campus Health](#) (919-966-2281) or send a web portal message to request a test.

Step Two: Self-quarantine and update your PI. You must be cleared by Campus Health before returning to work.

This should be covered by your insurance and there are no out of pocket costs for symptomatic COVID-19 testing due to the CARES Act.

There are no walk-in appointments at the ACC RDC.

If you are a student or postdoctoral trainee and have private insurance, Campus Health can still see you and courtesy file with your insurance company for labs/xray related to COVID-19 diagnosis
