

### PRISM Student Cost Breakdown for Mentors

Faculty/Mentors who agree to mentor and hire a PRISM student should be able to financially commit the following to each PRISM scholar in their research group. Amounts are subject to change and will be evaluated yearly.

Student Stipend	One year, annual salary for the first year	\$34, 000
Health Insurance	Student Blue Plan with BCBS	\$3,586 per year, per student
Student Tuition	Tuition for one graduate level class per year. Based on 3 credit hour course	\$1,794 (NC Resident)/\$4,902 (Non-Resident) per semester, per student
Student Fees	Fees for one graduate level class per year	\$258 per semester, per student
Non-Degree seeking Student Application Fee	Fee to apply to Non-Degree Seeking Studies program so students are eligible to enroll in graduate-level course	\$80 per student
Campus Health Fee	MOU with Campus Health Center so students can access health care services on campus (includes CAPS)	\$510 per student, per year
PRISM Program Fee*	Program Fee per semester, per student	January-May (5 months)- \$200 June-July (2 months)- \$100 August-December (5 months)-\$200
Fringe	Fringe at 9.490%	\$3226.60 per student, per year
Total	Non-hourly stipend, tuition and fees for one course, health insurance and campus health access, PRISM program access	<b>\$43,954.60/ NC Resident</b> <b>\$47,062.60/Non-Resident</b>

\*Program fee will be evaluated yearly based on changes and additions to program

Student stipend, fringe, tuition and fees will be charged directly to the student support funding source, such as a grant CFS. Health insurance, Campus Health access fee, Non-Degree seeking Student Application Fee, and PRISM program fee will be invoiced to the mentor's department/program. These costs will be invoiced twice a year, with a funding transfer submitted to charge the student support funding source.
