

Preoperative Checklist

Pediatric CT Surgery

Patient Mrn Sticker

- OR AND Anesthesia consent forms signed and in the chart/ uploaded to epic
- ID band on the patient
- Preoperative labs to be ordered and collected
 - Type and Screen and Abo/Rh performed **and active**
 - CBC, BMP, Mg, Phos, coags
 - Pregnancy test if female > 8 yo or if has started menstruation
 - Blood products to be ordered for OR
 - PRBCs: 2u for bypass case (1 full unit/ 1 split unit)
 - 1u for non-bypass
 - FFP: if patient < 10kg (1 unit)
- Preoperative testing to be ordered and performed
 - RPP/Covid-19
 - Needs to be collected within 3 days of OR
 - If positive contact anesthesia and surgical teams
 - For rapid turn around of results, place this order:
 - Respiratory pathogen panel with Covid-19 - symptomatic
 - Select stat, nasopharyngeal swab
 - When asked if symptomatic as defined by CDC select **NO**
 - From the drop down select “admission for transplant” or “cardiac surgery” (this will expedite the results to a 4 hour turn around time)
 - EKG performed and in the chart and media tab in epic
 - Pre-op CXR performed the day before surgery
 - Urinalysis with reflex culture
 - Pre-op echo to assess function
 - To be ordered for all CT surgery patients at their pre-op visit. **If the patient has had an echo within two weeks of their surgical date, consult with Cardiology Echo Reader to determine if study needs to be repeated at the pre-op visit.

- Miscellaneous orders to be placed preoperatively
 - Chlorhexidine bath x 2 (night before surgery and morning of surgery)
 - Nasal mupirocin
 - Apply to each nare the night before surgery, the morning of surgery, and bid x 5 days post op
 - Oral peridex
 - Swish and spit the night before surgery, the morning of and bid x 5 days post op (intubated or not)
- NPO at _____
 - Time determined by anesthesia team
- IVF ordered, change PN to IVF at _____
 - Time determined by anesthesia and pcicu team
- Stop anticoagulation at _____
 - Consult with surgical team for time preference
- Antibiotics to be ordered in the OR by Anesthesia
 - To be continued 48 hours postoperatively
- RN confirms (**before midnight**) that blood has been released to HemoBank
