Note: Fellows are granted 4 weeks of vacation/year, which can be taken in 1 week increments. Elective/research blocks occur in 4 week increments. Vacation may shift the timing of those weeks but will not replace them. Four weeks of elective/research time are required to fulfill those rotations.

Inpatient Pediatric Hospital Medicine Services:

PMA - Includes general pediatric patients and co-management of pediatric nephrology , endocrinology, and genetic/metabolic patients. Supervising responsibilities for residents, interns, and medical students.

PMB - Includes general pediatric patients and co-management of pediatric neurology/neurosurgery patients. Supervising responsibilities for residents, interns, and medical students.

PMW- Includes general pediatrics patients, plastic surgery co-management, newborn care, pediatric consults for surgical subspecialty and psychiatry services. No regular resident/medical student rotators.

Possible Electives: PICU (strongly encouraged), Pediatric Infectious Diseases (strongly encouraged), Child Protection/Advocacy (strongly encouraged), Point-Of-Care Ultrasound, Teaching/Medical Education, Quality Improvement, Pediatric Burn Surgery, Pediatric Pulmonology, Newborn Deliveries and Care, Emergency Medicine, Procedures, Administration or Advocacy, Global Health, Genetics, Pediatric Allergy and Immunology, Pediatric Cardiology, Pediatric Gastroenterology and Hepatology, Pediatric Hematology and Oncology, Pediatric Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Pediatric Radiology, Pediatric Rheumatology, Pediatric Surgery, Technology/Complex Care (follow RT, wound care, NSGY, complex care)

Due to regular co-management of nephrology and neurology teams, fellows wishing to do an elective in these areas would need to provide a written letter of request stating their desire and reasons
