### ABOUT DR. CHEN

Dr. Wunian Chen is a Clinical Instructor in the Department of Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation and the Department of Family Medicine at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He uses acupuncture and other traditional Chinese Medicine approaches to treat patients with high blood pressure, back pain, depression, joint pain, fibromyalgia, hot flashes, fatigue, headaches, and other health conditions.

Dr. Chen studied acupuncture, with a focus on the principles of both Chinese and Western medicine, at the Hubei College of Traditional Chinese Medicine. He practiced herbal medicine, acupuncture, and Western medicine in a community hospital until moving to North Carolina.

Dr. Chen's practice philosophy is built around delivering compassionate and intelligent care to patients to help optimize functionality. He is licensed by the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM) to offer acupuncture and oriental medicine services.
