PGY2 Night Float Rotation: COMPETENCY-BASED GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The NIGHT FLOAT rotation represents the in-house night coverage of the Trauma/Acute Care Surgery Service.

Shifts are 12 hours in duration, and the residents will work a maximum of 6 shifts per week, with a 24-hour respite per week.

A total of 4-5 weeks will be spent on this service, depending on the number of categorical general surgery residents, designated residents, and integrated plastic surgery residents are available for each academic year.
