- Changes to Selective Grading Proposal
 - Currently: course selective leaders submit a grade and there is a numerical score generated from common assessment form
 - Concern: currently policy does not have same correspondence, score that a student gets from their form does not correspond with grade ex score of 91 but get a high pass
 - Difference between elective and selective grades
 - Proposal: align with numerical score ect 91-100 will be honors, 80-89 will be high pass ect, make all individualization phase courses be graded in the same manner, proposal approved
